Coaches Game Day Check List

→ Coach\Team Manager with Badge

 To be in the coaching area during a match you are required to have a current coach/team manager badge for the team. If there is not a coach or manager with a valid badge present at the game then a forfeit could be issued.

→ Game Report

 Ensure you have the game report for the correct game. Game reports are available on the website under Resources >> Forms.

→ North Texas Roster

 Be sure that you have an updated printed copy of your North Texas Roster. Your North Texas Roster is available to print via your team account on the GotSoccer.com website.

→ Player ID Cards (Player Cards)

O Player ID cards are required for the U13 through U19 teams. Player ID cards are obtained through the EMSA office. If you do not have your player ID cards, contact the EMSA office to arrange a time to pick them up. If a player is missing their player card then he or she will not be able to participate in the match. Note: Player ID cards are not issued or required for the U4 through U12 teams.

→ Players Equipment

 Ensure that your players have all of their equipment to include proper footwear (soccer cleats), shin guards, socks covering the shin guards, a jersey with a unique number, and no jewelry.

→ Nets & Flags

• The home team/association is responsible for ensuring that the nets & flags are in place on the field before game time.

→ Report the Score

- The home team is responsible for reporting the score of the game. Scores must be reported within 48 hours after the game. You can report the score by calling it in using
 - the telephone number on the bottom part of the game report the referee will provide you after the game.
